An entity can be an object that occupies space, an event that occurs in time, a concept (such as the theory of relativity) or a relationship (such as treaty between nations). Most entities are complex in that they contain two or more of these entity types.





It didn't invent the touchscreen, or mobile e-mail, or that cool portrait/landscape switching that we now take for granted.


Apple didn't invent the MP3 player.


It just invented a better way to call and pay for them that took advantage of the smartphone platform.



I believe that design has the potential to transform how organizations develop products, services, processes, strategies, and cultures.




